Construction date: 1912 -Two-part commercial block - two entrances - decorative brick work - belt course - smaller upper story windows



8 N. Main Street- Leffingwell Building

Construction date: 1916 - Two-part commercial block – diagonal corner entrance – decorative brick work – transoms



12 N. Main Street- Palace Barber Shop

Construction date: 1902 – two-part commercial block – elaborate cornice – radiating voussoirs – recessed entrance



14 and 16 N. Main Street- Beast RX and Jim's Shoe Repair

Construction date: 1907 – one-part commercial block – plate glass windows – recessed entrance – transoms – kick plates – business name plate



18 and 20 N. Main Street- Main Bar & Karaoke and Q's Furniture

Construction date: 1907 – newer one-part commercial block – flat roof – recessed entrance – large plate glass windows – kick plates

Construction date: 1918 – one-part commercial block – transoms – large plate glass windows – kick plates – decorative brick work – corbelled cornice – recessed entrance

Platting date: 1893 – alleys are important elements to historic districts because they indicate how buildings were used.

Construction date: 1968

Does not meet standard: Falls outside of period of significance

Exceptionally Significant Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1920

Most defining elements are lost but building is significant because of its construction date, building form, and flat roof.



116 Strong Street- Fink Ink

Construction date: 1920 – one-part commercial block – flat roof – recessed entrance – decorative brick work – kick plates – large plate glass windows

Non-Contributing Resource

Construction date: 1973

Does not meet standard: Falls outside of period of significance

Construction date: 1930 – one-part commercial block – stepped parapet – flush entrance – large plate glass windows – kick plate – decorative brick work



122 N. Main Street- Stylish Nails

Construction date: 1925

Most defining elements of façade are lost but architecturally significant for its building form and entrance.

Construction date: 1971

Does not meet standard: Falls outside of period of significance

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1920-1930 – two-story commercial block – large plate glass windows – rusticated stone sills – rusticated stone foundation – second entrance – transoms – decorative brick work – keystone

Construction date: 1917 – one-part commercial block – false front – recessed entrance – parapet – name plate – transoms

Construction date: 1910-1917 – one-part commercial block – false front – decorative brick work – recessed entrance – name plate – parapet



29 N. Main Street- Los Corrales

Contributing Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1966

Falls outside of period of significance, but is architecturally significant for its building form and entrance.



33 N. Main Street- Greg A. Thaler Learning Center

Contributing Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1947

Falls outside of period of significance, but is architecturally significant for building form and recessed entrance.



39 N. Main Street- Cora's Closet

Exceptionally Significant Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1897 – one-part commercial block – large plate glass windows – decorative kick plates – recessed entrance – name plate



43 N. Main Street- Creative U

Exceptionally Significant Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1895 – one-part commercial block – decorative cornice – corbels – large plate glass windows – recessed entrance – decorative kick plates



45 N. Main Street- La Estrellita

Exceptionally Significant Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1882 – one-part commercial block – stepped parapet on side decorative cornice – ornamental molding – large plate glass windows – recessed entrance

101 N. Main Street- Elks Lodge

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1910 – two-part commercial block – diagonal corner entrance – multiple entrances – ornamental plaster work – decorative brick block



117 N. Main Street- Something Brewery

Construction date: 1920 – two-part commercial block – recessed entrance – large plate glass windows – decorative brick work – belt course – transoms – corbelled cornice



119 N. Main Street

Platting date: 1920-1926 – one-part commercial block – large plate glass windows – recessed entrance – hydrastone building material



121 N. Main Street

Construction date: 1920 – one-part commercial block – decorative brick work – large plate glass windows – recessed entrance – ornamental molding – kick plate - transoms



123 N. Main Street

Exceptionally Significant Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1897

Most defining elements are lost, but building is significant because of its construction date, building form, and recessed entrance.



139 N. Main Street- Brighton Blade

Non-Contributing Resource

Construction date: 1947

Falls outside of period of significance- the front façade does not illustrate historic significance

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1935

Most defining elements are lost, but is architecturally significant for building form and recessed entrance.

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1934

Most defining elements are lost, but architecturally significant for building form and original entrance.



155 N. Main Street- Laundromat

Exceptionally Significant Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1948

Falls outside of period of significance, but building is architecturally significant for building form- kick plates- large plate glass windows- name plate- decorative brick work



161 N. Main Street

Exceptionally Significant Resource

Historically Significant Elements

Construction date: 1914-1920 – two-part commercial block – decorative brick work – name plates – recessed entrance – stepped parapet
